Or that group advocacy resulted in BC becoming the 1st province to put free menstrual products in all schools to ensure that hygiene isn't a barrier to education?

LEARN ABOUT SOME OF THE BIG ISSUES WOMEN FACE AROUND THE WORLD

This year, the United Nations focus is "Choose to Challenge", encouraging individuals and communities to recognize and call out gender bias and inequality.

Globally, some of the biggest issues for women are disparities in access to education & hygiene, under-representation in government & economics, and a stark over-representation as victims of violence.
