Children's Ministry - Our in-person programming for children is as follows: **The Nursery** (Room 118) is open but unsupervised for children aged 0-2. A **Preschool Class** (Room 120) is available for children aged 2-5. **Gradeschool Children** taking part in Sunday School will start in the sanctuary for a couple of songs before being invited to their class (Grade 1-3, Room 122 & Grade 4-6, Room 124). Please accompany them to meet their leaders if it is their first time. *All children will need to be picked up & signed out by their parents/guardians.*
